**ORDER**

**SUBJECT: - APPEAL IN R/O SHRI MUMTAZ QURESHI, Madhya Pradesh.**

This is an online RTI First Appeal dated 06/05/2020 bearing registration No. DOHRE/A/E/20/00020 of Shri Mumtaz Qureshi, Madhya Pradesh against CPIO's communication dated 04/05/2020 in connection with his RTI application dated 21/04/2020 bearing registration No. DOHRE/R/T/20/00038.

2. The grounds of Appeals are incomplete, misleading or false.

3. I have gone through the application of the appellant, information furnished to him by the CPIO and record of the case. In his application, vide dated 21/04/2020 registration No. DOHRE/R/T/20/00038, the Appellant had sought the following information:


- i. Which organisation have been authorised by the Department of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of India, for the promotion and research of electro-homeopathy.

3. The information was sent to the applicant by the CPIO, vide his letter dated 04/05/2020, stating that the alternative system of medicine is not recognised by this Department. Therefore, this Department does not authorise to impart, research, promotion and development in alternative therapy courses.

4. From the above, it will be seen that the requisite information was provided to the Appellant. Since electrohomeopathy itself is not recognised system of medicine, the Department of Health Research has not authorised any organisation for promotion and research in this system. It will, thus be seen that the information originally provided to the Appellant was generally in order, and, there is no apparent ground for any appeal against the response of CPIO to the query raised by the Appellant. Therefore, I do not find any ground to interfere with the communication of the CPIO.

5. With this, the said appeal, dated 06/05/2020, stands disposed off.

6. In case, the Appellant is not satisfied with this order, he may prefer Second Appeal to the Central Information Commission.
